Our Vice Presidents: Colin Jones, Michael Quailley and Chris Hayes who are always there when the Association needs a hand.

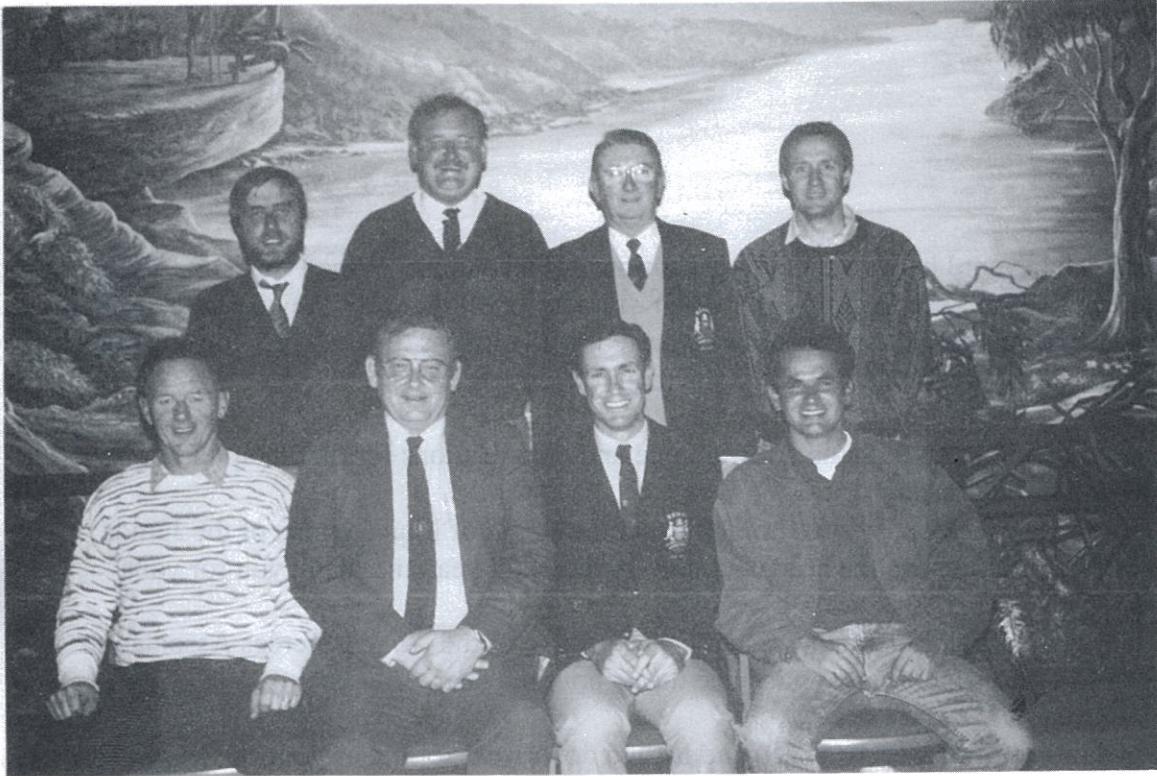
Bill Lalor, Patron, thank you for your guidance and support.

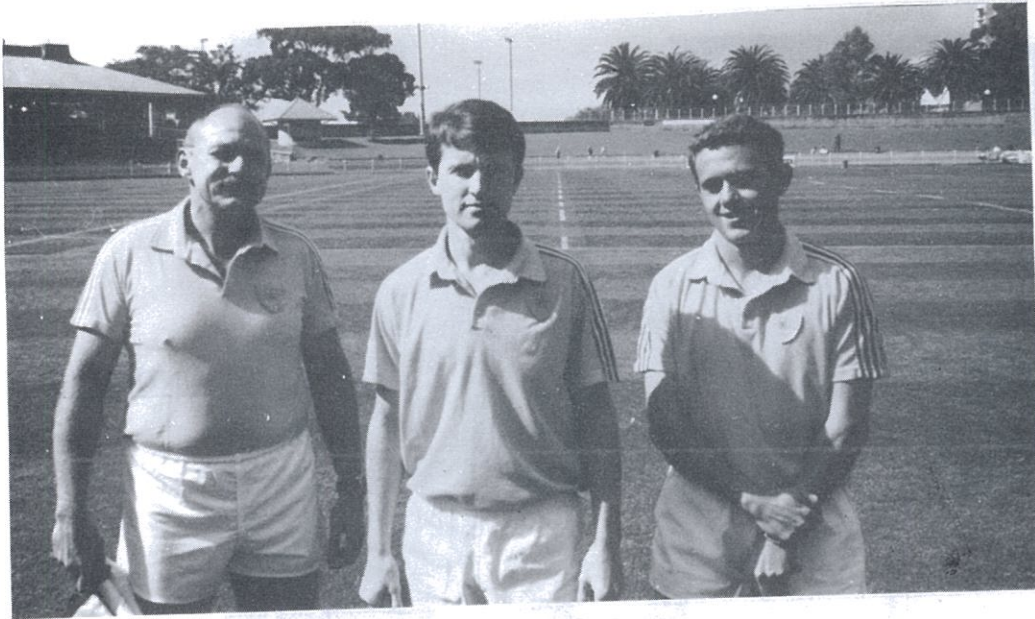

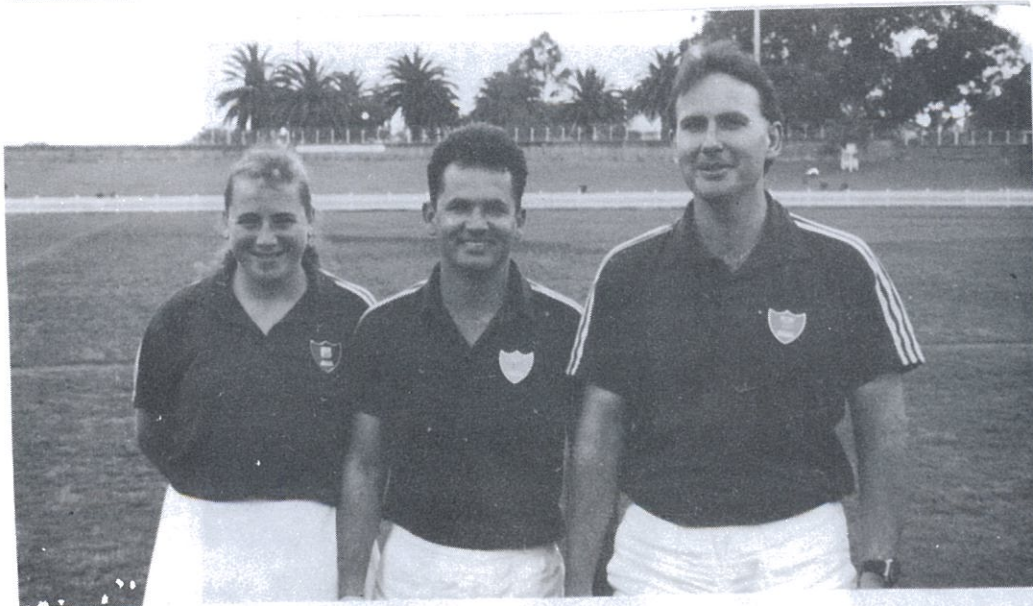

It has been quite a difficult year financially for the Association and its members. The major contributing factors have been the hosting of the NSW Referees Golf Day and the lack of sponsorship.

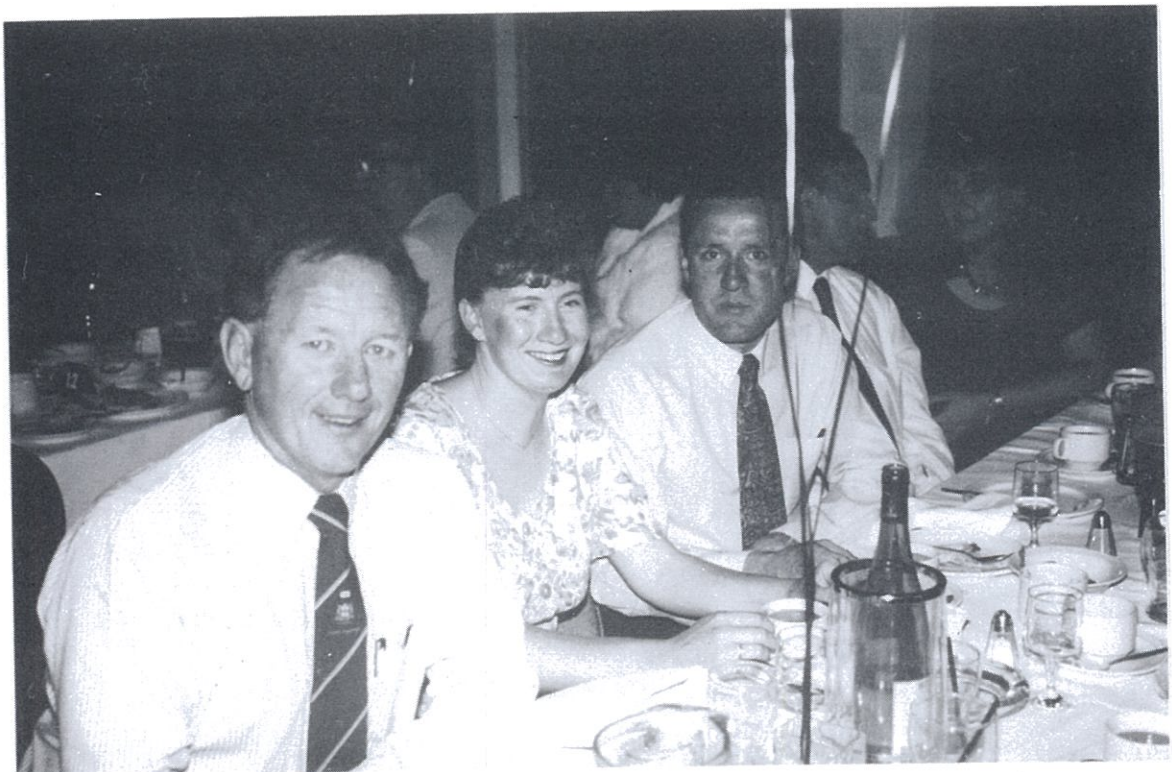
The Golf Day resulted in a net loss to the Association of \$1828.50 and certainly placed a heavy burden on funds at the start of the year.

COACHING REPORT

Training commenced at Waitara Oval on Monday Nights late January in preparation for the 1993 season. At this stage of the year training consisted mostly of physical conditioning work in order to have our Referees at a reasonable level of fitness in readiness for the commencement of the competition.

Attendances early on were satisfactory with our "regulars" making up the majority of the group. During the Season proper we numbered usually between 15-20 referees and this remained steady during the year.

The Coaches met early in the year to set some guidelines for the coming season. One of the recommendations was that an attendance record be kept for each training night with the records shown in the Annual Report. The records for this year follow this report.

A number of variations were introduced to training this year. Whilst the innovations may not be new to refereeing they were new to North Sydney. The innovations included the introduction of drills and the wider use of Video as a coaching medium.

On a number of occasions during the year, video's were shown after the training sessions as part of the coaching process. Like anything new there was some hesitation with the introduction of the video sessions. The policy of the coaches was that any refereeing "bloopers" would be first shown to the individual referee and permission was sought from that referee before showing it to the rest of the group.

Almost without exception all referees allowed the tapes to be shown. The value of the video was slowly recognised and this was very evident on our last training night when a most constructive discussion was held.

Whilst it is easy to show mistakes, the coaches also ensured that many good points were also viewed. Towards the end of the season it was felt that the value of the video was certainly evident and accepted. We hope to expand its use next year in and attempt to ensure a wider coverage of games.

Special thanks to Lester Boyle of the Berowra Club for his assistance in videoing games for us. Lester allowed us to use tapes from the Berowra games after they had been viewed by the club during the year and also videoed the Final Series exclusively for the use of the referees. Also thanks to Jim Neal who spent countless hours watching tapes and putting them into package ready for viewing.

Two incidents deserve special mention. Michael Haynes is still trying to solve the mystery of the disappearing whistle and Bob Talbots magnificent effort to award a try whilst sitting on the ground must be kept for prosperity.

The introduction of drills as part of the training night was seen as an attempt to have referees practice and in some cases adjudicate on phases of play which occur during the game. The drills followed our regular physical session and became an important part of the coaching process. The drills included such things as adjudicating on forward passes, running up and back the 10m, positional play and touch judge drills such as corner post decisions, touch-line plays and penalty kicks. The idea of these drills is to simulate as best as possible actual playing conditions and occurrences during games and to have referees ruling on these decisions on a repetition basis.

The aim is that when the occurrence does happen in a game it will be "second nature" and we will come up with the right call. Again it is planned to extend the drills next year.

During the season, special guests were invited to attend sessions and give talks on various aspects of the game. Jack Harris was welcomed early in the year to offer his knowledge and experience to our referees. Jack has visited North Sydney on a number of occasions and always keeps us interested with his talks. Phil Cooley, an active member of the NSW Referees Association and a member of the Committee attended a meeting and spoke on his career and development from Junior Representatives through to First Grade Centres. His talk was very informative and the insight he gave to future plans for refereeing on regards to expansion were quite interesting.

John Quinn attended a training night towards the end of the season. This was just a "Pep Talk" leading up to these important games. John spoke about many aspects of the game none more important than the presentation of referees on and off the field. Special thanks to Jack, Phil and John for their contribution and for giving up their time to assist.

This year proved to be an innovative year in regards to coaching and development of referees. We hope to build on that next year in an attempt to build on the success we have had in grade in recent years. It was no secret that the Senior Grade Grand Finals were refereed by our fittest referees and it is hoped that all referees will continue to train during the off season in preparation for 1994.

I take this opportunity to wish all the Best for Xmas and see you in the New Year.

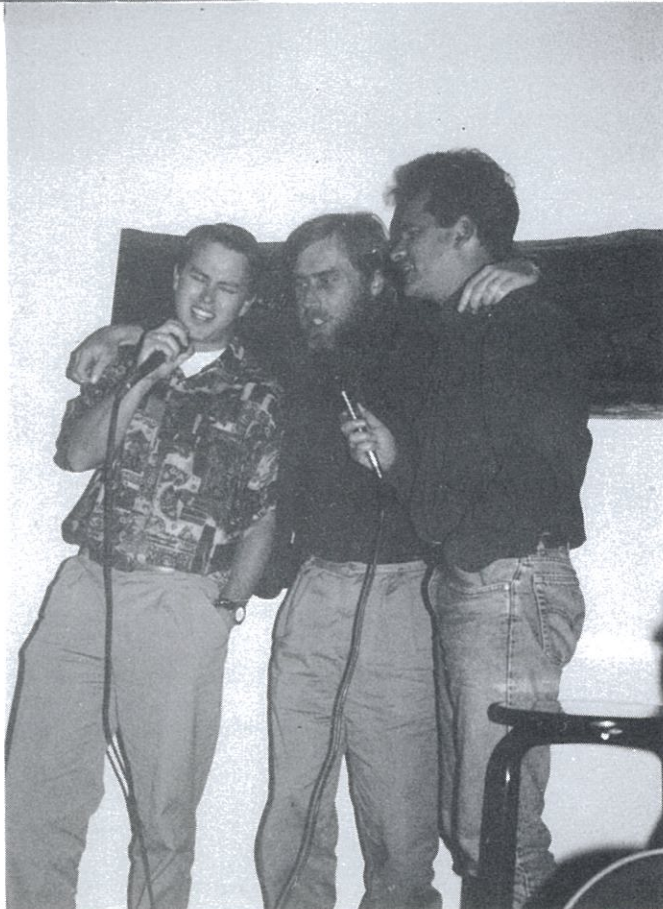
